Lt Col Joseph P. Gonzales is the Director of Operations, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 510, at the University of New Mexico in Albuquerque, New Mexico. As an Associate Professor of Aerospace Studies, he is responsible for educating, training, and mentoring cadets to prepare them to commission as Second Lieutenants and serve as leaders in the United States Air Force and United States Space Force.

Lt Col Gonzales graduated from the University of New Mexico and earned his commission through AFROTC Detachment 510 in 2004. He has served as a mission-ready F-15E Strike Eagle Weapons Systems Officer and EA-18G Electronic Warfare Officer, holding various positions in three operational flying squadrons. As an Air Liaison Officer, he served as Assistant Director of Operations, Flight Commander, Air Liaison Officer Instructor, Airborne, and Joint Terminal Attack Controller. He also served as Director of Operations for the 548th Combat Training Squadron, Commander of Detachment 1, 20th Air Support Operations Squadron at Fort Polk, Louisiana, and Commander of Detachment 1, 6th Combat Training Squadron at Will Rogers Air National Guard Base, Oklahoma, and Operating Location – Alpha, Fort Sill, Oklahoma.



Prior to assuming his current position, Lt Col Gonzales served as Acting Deputy Chief of Aviation Safety, Chief of Aviation Safety Assurance, and Chief of Aviation Mishap Investigations for Headquarters Air Force Safety Center at Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico.
