Alombro is the Deputy Branch Chief for AIM-260A Joint Advanced Tactical Missile (JATM) Hardware Production and Design, Air Dominance Division, Armament Directorate, Air Force Life Cycle Management Center, Eglin AFB, Florida. As the Deputy Branch Chief, he is responsible for 35 personnel executing an ACAT ID equivalent \$35B+ contract, leading all system design, qualification and fielding for the Air Force and Navy's #1 Air-to-Air weapon.

Major Alombro earned his commission in 2014 through AFROTC after graduating from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Daytona Beach Florida. He is a career acquisition officer who has served in a variety of management and leadership roles as both an engineer and program manager, across multiple phases of the acquisition lifecycle. Prior to his current assignment, Major Alombro served as the Deputy Chief Engineer for Space Force's Innovation and Prototyping Delta where he designed, built and fielded satellite ground stations and was a certified satellite flight director performing on-orbit missions to evaluate software and technology before transitioning them to the operational community.
