## LIEUTENANT COLONEL ROBERT G. LACY

Lt Col Robert G. Lacy is an Instructor in the Department of Airpower at Air Command and Staff College where he instructs the Joint Air Operations Planning, Leadership and Profession of Arms, Airpower Strategy and Operations, and Contemporary Warfare courses. Additionally, he serves as the Deputy Course director to the Pacific Air Forces Specialization conducting sponsored research for USPACAF.

Lt Col Lacy commissioned in 2006 through ROTC after graduating the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He completed undergraduate navigator training as an Electronic Warfare Officer at Randolph AFB, Texas in 2007, and his first operational assignment was to Davis- Monthan AFB, Ariz. flying the EC-130H COMPASS CALL. In 2013 he transitioned to AFSOC to fly the MC-130H COMBAT TALON II at Hurlburt Field, Florida. While at Hurlburt Field he was a founding member the AFSOC Cochran Group, which advises the AFSOC Commander on strategy and leads future concept development. Additionally, he led Specialized Mobility Tactics development and evaluation for AFSOC. Prior to his current assignment Lt Col Lacy was the Director of Wing Projects at the 58<sup>th</sup> Special Operations Wing, Kirtland AFB, NM.



Lt Col Lacy is a rated Master Combat Systems Officer with over 600 combat hours and has deployed in support of combat operations for Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, New Dawn, Odyssey Dawn, Unified Protector, Freedom's Sentinel/Resolute Support, and Inherent Resolve. He is a graduate of the US Air Force Weapons School and holds a Master in Military Operational Art and Science degree from Air University as well as a Master of Natural Resource Development degree from Texas A&M University.
